- b) Social Club move/rebuild report – Will fit in Bay 10. Cost will be \$2,000 & materials. Can salvage porch/overhang. Proposed design will have door, 2 windows and wrap around deck with removable railing. Bay needs to be graded prior to move. \$1000 to do study on Bays 7-12. Should have land owner approval of plan. Motion to get a plan for dirt work for January meeting, \$1000 fee – Cliff, MEM Consultants, seconded, discussion, vote, passed. Wild Horse John will work.
- c) Bays 7 and 8 combination/new bay – We will not remove berm to combine. New bay cancelled. Clean up side berms and finish Bay 12.
