VI. Open issues

- a) Siding, door and AC covers progress –Bernie is still working on siding. Jerry hasn't had time to fix door. AC covers are on.
- b) Implementation of no smoking in pavilion enclosed areas and long range house – Signs will be put up.
- c) Long range target replacement – Dick talked with Pat Grashorn (Executioner) Sick cow target and small buffalo target needs to be replaced. Dick has some prices on steel and will get price on cutting it to shape.
- d) Excess CR funds investment – Bill took check to Investment Centers Of America (ICA) and put it in money market account.
- e) Escrow investment – CD will be done with Security First Bank.
- f) Club combination changes – Cowboy bays combinations have been changed.
- g) Cattle Brand Inspection Convention – Spoke with Lee Romsa and told him Board has approved it. No preference of Monday or Tuesday. Dates are July 17-20, 2011 so action transferred to Doris for PR to monitor.
- h) Gravel pricing update – Jerry will run numbers back by Simon Construction again as they seem low. Still trying to get a hold of Ram Trucking.
- i) Report of Financial Review Committee – Report is finished. No one was there to answer questions. Tabled.
- j) Bob Poch had a suggestion about how we are looking at the by-laws – Put it on website and have ability to comment on website. Dave will check into it with our webmaster to see if possible.
- k) Defensive Pistol – Jerry now has a complete set of rules. Should be ready to kick off in May.
- l) New range rules – Let Don know if anything needs changed as we are making a new sign for the gate.

VII. New business

- a) Black powder shoot – Mike Penz (Slufoot), formerly a member, would like to have his group use part of range east of Bay 12 (the valley) once per month. They have a small group of 6-10 people and until recently shot at the Cheyenne Police Range. They would also like to park an old trailer with the target materials on the site. Discussion as to safety conflict with Bay 12, fire safety with black powder use, and cost. Motion to work with Crow Creek Fur Co. to use Bay 1 for a monthly shoot to be set as the 3rd Sunday of the month, seconded, discussion, vote, accepted.
- b) Motion made to set policy that organizations that wish to use range must have a member that is a member of the range. If they use their own equipment, set up, and tear down we will charge them \$5 per person per shoot. Seconded, discussion, vote, accepted.
- c) Available targets offer – Don received a note from High Lonesome Drifters that they will be selling some Action targets like some we have. 29 complete sets and 7 extra stands. Price compared to new make it a good deal. We will need to pick them up after this year's Cody shoot in June. Motion to buy targets from Cody, seconded, discussion, vote, accepted.
- d) Wild Bunch stages/shoots – We will do a shoot next month.

- e) Shoot start time change – Change Monthly Shoot to summer hours.
Registration at 8 AM and shoot at 9 AM.
- f) Fun Shoots-continuance/cost – Continue to do when not doing a Makeup Shoot. Cost stays the same.
