

# **Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. Policy Statements**

## **Policy I Range Safety Rules**

1. Always keep your guns pointed in a safe direction.
2. Always keep your finger off trigger until ready to shoot.
3. Always keep guns unloaded until ready to use.
4. Know your target and what is beyond.
5. Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
6. Know how to use your gun safely.
7. Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
8. Wear eye and ear protection.
9. No alcohol or drugs before or while shooting.
10. Store guns so they are not accessible to "unauthorized personnel".

## **Range Use Rules**

1. Obey all posted signs.
2. Persons on range must provide membership card and a photo ID on request.
3. One guest per member on range.
4. Members are responsible for the actions of their guests and pets.
5. Both are to be supervised and/or restrained.
6. Do not shoot...over the berms...over the backstops or from outside a shooting bays rear most limits.
7. Targets and stands are brought in by members. No glass-period! Clean-up after yourself. "Leave no brass, hulls, trash, bottles or targets".
8. Do not shoot: tracer, explosive or 50bmg or larger.
9. Do not shoot any animals on range, move livestock gently from shooting area!
10. Only shoot "rim fire" cartridges in the "22 bay"
11. Only shoot "long range area" from the "range house" or "covered firing line". "Cowboy bays" and "cowboy steel targets" are reserved for "cowboy action members only".
12. Locked gates are to be locked and closed gates are to be closed after passage.
13. Key cards are club property. \$10.00 replacement!

Violation of any of these rules may result in termination of membership. A members' use of a key card acknowledges compliance with these rules.
