Policy VII

Range Use for Special Events

1. Use of the Cheyenne Regulators range for special events and other group shooting disciplines will be coordinated with:
 - a. Public relations director to insure the event does not present a scheduling conflict with other range activities.
 - b. Range master to insure that the range is safely capable of handling the event.
 - c. Before being presented to the board for approval.
2. Event Coordinator: will be a member of the Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. and either a certified NRA-range safety officer (RSO) or have other appropriate training as determined by the range master.
3. "Range Facilities" fees of \$10.00 per person for the use of more than two (2) shooting bays, classroom or the long range shooting area for the special event: will be incurred by all persons participating in an event at the Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. range. Fees are for the duration of the event and are exclusive of any other fees.
4. "Shooting Bay" use fees of \$5.00 per person for the use of a single shooting bay for the special event will be incurred by all persons participating in an event at the Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. range. Fees are for the duration of the event and are exclusive of any fees.
5. A Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. waiver will be signed by all persons participating in the event, in any capacity.
6. Event Coordinator: will submit to the Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. treasurer; an event cash report, fees and the signed waivers for all participants within three (3) business days of the event completion.
7. Event Coordinator: will supervise the event, care of the regulator property, cleanup and filing of all reports pertaining to the event.
8. Range improvements, props, targets and any other items of a permanent nature must be approved by the Cheyenne Regulators executive board before the modifications and become the sole property of the Cheyenne Regulators, Inc. upon completion of the event unless otherwise agreed to in writing.
